PASTOR'S CORNER

For Father Mathew's Intentions

Sharing the Blessing of the Good News - The theme of today's readings is evangelization. Hence, in the First Reading, we find God selecting and sending forth the humble Amos to prophesy to His people. This is the precursor to the evangelization in today's Gospel. Responsorial, Psalm 85, defines the Good News and its fruits. The Good News is a proclamation of God as our deliverer and savior. The psalmist describes a world in which the people are saved from alienation and sin, a world at peace, where profound goodness and righteousness reign and people no longer live in fear and confusion. In this world we are at home in God's presence. In the Second Reading, St Paul clarifies the Christian concept of predestination. This does not mean that everything is pre-ordained, and we have no free will. Predestination means that God always invites us to His love, and with our free will we can accept or reject His invitation. All are chosen and on the list of invited guests to the Lord's banquet, but all are free to choose otherwise, hate over love, sin over virtue. Predestination means not that we must choose God, but that we can choose Him, since He chose us first. God created us for love; obeying His will and loving as Christ. Again, we hear that the Holy Spirit is God's down payment on our eternal inheritance as God's possession. Even in this life we begin to experience a foretaste of Heaven's joy. In today's Gospel, Jesus passes on His authority and sends out His disciples to proclaim the Good News, to evangelize the world. commissioning carries great weight. The disciples were to take very little with them, trusting in Divine Providence. If welcomed, a blessing falls to their hosts. If their listeners reject them, then they are rejecting the Good News and so will be cursed; for their lives will lack the grace, guidance, and consolation of the Good News. (CBCo)
