Divine Mercy Recreates Us

In the First Reading, St Luke, perhaps the first Vocations' Director, presents the good side of Christian life, to win over the pagans to Christianity. This first, early Christian community is described as dedicated to the celebration of the Eucharist, prayer, and mutual support. It's easy to get caught up in community difficulties... we're reminded to look beyond them to see God working among us. • The Responsorial highlights God's everlasting mercy, while maintaining fear of the Lord, i.e., the awe that recognizes His goodness and mercy. We know how hard it can be to forgive... here we get a small glimpse into the depth of God's merciful love. He destroys sin's power by showing us even greater mercy; hence our great rejoicing at the end of the Easter octave. We don't ignore life's problems, but confront them confident that nothing can separate us from God's love. He loved us so much that He died for us. How much more will He lead us through life's present trials by trusting in His Mercy. • In the Second Reading, St Peter focuses on our Baptismal dignity. As God's adopted children, our inheritance is imperishable, undefiled, un-fading. When we view suffering as a means of our purification, we learn what's really important and worth living and dying for. Suffering purifies our intentions by teaching us to trust God's providence unconditionally. It helps us see sin as living in a way that falls short of our new dignity. In His death and resurrection, Jesus taught us that we are too precious to sell ourselves short; He thought so highly of us that He died for us! • Today's Gospel is Jesus' first appearance to His disciples after His ignominious death on the cross. He dispels their fear, greeting them with words of peace. Like a flashback to the creation story in Genesis, He breathes God's Spirit into them, recreating them in His Spirit. The handing on of the Holy Spirit, like Pentecost, is a powerful outpouring of love for forgiveness of sin. Jesus appeared in the flesh, Thomas touched His wounds, these are concrete evidence of Jesus' resurrection. All generations of the Faithful, since these eyewitnesses, are praised for believing without seeing. May our belief and trust in Jesus and His Divine Mercy take ever deeper root in our hearts.

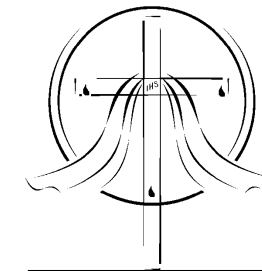
